## **End of term activities**

Dear Parent/Carer

At the end of term we would like to offer the following activities to Year 9 students. We believe this package will allow them to continue unlocking both their academic and personal potential by further developing their character allowing them to be successful, well-rounded young people when they leave Year 11 for their post-16 education.

As you can see from the overview some activities are linked to our PSHE statutory requirements and some are more closely linked to ASPIRE and the development of students' character. To support our planning for these activities we are enquiring as to which activity students would like to attend on Thursday 14th July. We would like them to give us their top three choices so that we can then ensure they get one of their choices. We would like each student to complete the Google Form on their tutor group Google Classroom. This will need to be completed by Monday 6th June at 9am.

NO MONEY WILL BE REQUIRED AT THIS TIME. However once your child has been allocated their activity all monies must be paid via ParentPay by Monday 13th June. No payments or changes can be made after this date, and no refunds will be given.

# Thursday 14th July options

# Option 1 - Snowdome

This activity will take place at Tamworth Snowdome and students will return to school at approximately 5pm. Students will need to make alternative arrangements to get home from school. The price includes two hours of skiing tuition alongside two hours of ice skating, coach travel and insurance. No food or drink is included in the price of this activity and students will be required to bring a packed lunch. The cost of this trip is £40.00.

#### Option 2 - Oxford

This activity is designed to celebrate education and develop the high aspirations of our students. Students will get an opportunity to visit the Ashmolean Museum and enjoy a tour of the city & colleges alongside visiting other museums such as the Oxford natural history museum and Pitt Rivers Museum. This trip will not arrive back at school until approximately 6pm and therefore students will need to make alternative arrangements to get home from school. The price includes coach travel and insurance. No food or drink is included in the price of this activity and students will be required to bring a packed lunch. The cost of this trip is £14.00.

# Option 3 - Inflata Nation and Bowling - Telford

This activity will take place at Inflata Nation and Tenpin Telford. It is a fun-filled activity that students with high energy levels might enjoy. Telford Inflata Nation is awesome fun, with a massive super bouncy wall to wall inflatable arena featuring a host of Inflata Nation favourite activities. You'll see mega drop slides, a wobbly gladiator podium and a bouncy ball pool just to name a few. This trip will arrive back at school for 3pm. The price includes entry to both venues, one game of bowling and two hours of fun in Inflata Nation, coach travel and insurance. No food or drink is included in the price of this activity and students will be required to bring a packed lunch. The cost of this trip is £30.

# **Option 4 - Alton Towers**

This activity will take place at Alton Towers, Staffordshire and students will return to school for approximately 6pm. The price includes entry to the park, coach travel and insurance. No food or drink is included in the price of this activity and students will be required to bring a packed lunch or buy food from the park. The cost of this trip is £36.00.

# Option 5 - In school activities

These activities will be finalised closer to the day but may include creative arts and sporting activities. There will be no cost to the in-school activities.

Every effort is made to ensure the estimated cost of trips/activities is accurate and our policy is not to make a surplus. There may be occasions after making all associated payments a small surplus of funds remain, if this situation arises and the surplus is greater than 5% of the total trip cost and the calculated refund per person is greater than £10, refunds will be issued, otherwise any remaining funds will be retained and contributed to future activities.

# Friday 15th July

### Seaside trip for Year 9 - we would like all students in year 9 to attend this trip

We would like to take all of Year 9 to Weston-Super-Mare the day as a whole year group. When in Weston-Super-Mare the students will be able to enjoy time on the beach, in the arcades, around the shops etc with their friends. This trip will depart school at 9am and return at approximately 6pm. The cost of this trip will be £20 per student to include transport and insurance.

In order to enjoy the benefits that the enrichment days bring, students will be expected to maintain their high standards throughout the remainder of the school year, particularly with regards to uniform, attendance and behaviour.
