Weather Warning

As I'm sure you are aware, the weather forecast has predicted that we are going to be experiencing some very high temperatures at the beginning of next week. The current Department for Education guidance is for schools to remain open but to take additional measures to keep children safe. Therefore we have put in place an Extreme Heat Risk Assessment in order to keep students and staff as safe and comfortable as possible during the heatwave. Please see below the changes and measures that will be happening:

- There will be no outdoor PE lessons taking place after 11:00am.
- Sports Day has been moved from Monday 18th July to Wednesday 20th July, weather permitting.
- Students are not required to wear their blazers or ties on Monday. Tuesday and Wednesday they will be in their PE kits for SMSC Day and Sports Day.
- Year 12 will continue with lessons as normal on Monday but do not need to wear
 jackets or ties and will continue with their trip on Tuesday as planned.
- Classrooms that have been identified as becoming very warm will not be used.
- Students have been provided with additional indoor areas to use at break and lunchtime and time outside will be limited to 30 minutes.
- Students will be encouraged and allowed to refill water bottles throughout the day.

Can I please ask that you support us by ensuring your child;

- Has applied sun cream before leaving for school and has a bottle in their bag to re-apply during the day.
- Bring a water bottle to school with them.
- Has a sun hat / cap to wear when outdoors.

If you are concerned about your child due to an underlying medical condition which you feel may be affected by the heat, please contact your child's tutor and/or Head of House as soon as possible.
